Ballina Bowling & Recreation Club Presents The 2008 Wintersun Singles

The Club currently uses two tiffdwarf & one synthetic surface Green.
Where possible all players will have one game only on the synthetic surface.

Conditions of Play.

Games will be played under Bowls Australia "Laws of the Sport of Bowls" of September 2006 as amended.

Sectional Play:

Will be 3 games of first to 25 shots with no time limit commencing at 9:00 am.

Quarter Finals & Semi Finals

Will be first to 25 shots with no time limit.

Final

Will be 31 up with no time limit.

Sectional Play

The section winners will be decided on Wins & Margins. Should equality exist, the aggregate shots scored AGAINST each player will be divided into the aggregate shots which the player has scored. The highest result will be the winner. Should a tied result still occur then an extra end or ends will be played to determine the winner.

Bye or Forfeit

The player will be credited with a win & total margins divided by the number of games played in their section.

Trial Ends

No more than one end will be permitted prior to each game on day one, & only one prior to game one on day two.

Bowls Discs

Each player will use coloured bowls discs for all matches as per the colours in the program. In Post Sectional, Quarter Finals, Semi Finals & Finals matches if the colours clash, the players will toss & the loser will be asked to change their discs.

No Dead Ends Re-spot the jack.

There will be no dead ends. If the jack by the effect of play leaves the rink over the bank or over the side boundary or rebounds to distance of less than 20 metres from the mat line it will be replaced in the rink of play on the two metre mark on the centre line. If the two metre mark is occupied by a bowl the jack will be placed on the nearest available spot on the centre line towards the mat line, by the marker.

Restricted Movement:

Players during their games will be restricted in following their Bowls in accordance with

Appendix "A" (Conditions of Play) Section A.4.

Weather

Cessation of play due to inclement weather will only be declared by the umpire of the day. A bell will be sounded & play on all rinks will cease. Resumption of play will be announced when the greens are considered fit for play & any incomplete end will be declared dead (Law 50 Clause 2). In the event that any time is lost the tournament committee reserves the right to add a time limit for the completion of a game. Where a game is started but not completed under these circumstances the scores will stand as recorded at the cessation of play.

Disputes

Should a dispute arise during any match, the matter will be referred to the umpire whose decision will be final.
